Our aim is to keep you informed of ongoing developments related to the program, public health activities conducted by the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), and benefits provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA).

This year, we want to highlight ongoing benefits provided by the VA for Veterans and their family members who were potentially exposed to contaminated drinking water at Camp Lejeune from August 1, 1953, through December 31, 1987.
